VOLUNTEERING WITH THE TREVOR PROJECT

The Trevor Project is scaling its impact significantly over the next few years, enabling the recruitment and training of thousands of new volunteers. The increase in crisis services volunteers allows us to serve even more LGBTQ young people in crisis every year.

Volunteers are trained to support LGBTQ youth who reach out about issues such as coming out, LGBTQ identity, depression, and suicide. You can apply for volunteer opportunities from anywhere in the U.S. Join us and help save young LGBTQ lives.



TrevorLifeline volunteers are trained to answer calls from young people who feel suicidal or need a safe, non-judgmental place to talk. This is an onsite volunteer opportunity and those interested must live near our Call Centers, which are located in LA & NYC.



TrevorChat & TrevorText volunteers are trained to answer instant messages or texts online from young people. Volunteers need access to a computer in a private location with a strong internet connection, and should be comfortable with instant messaging.



Advocacy volunteers conduct outreach and research for state-level grassroots campaigns supporting LGBTQ youth across the country.
